## Japan's Occupation on the Chinese Fringe: Manchuria, Vietnam and Syonan

This Workshop focuses on the contrasting fortunes of the Japanese and of Asian regions in which they were involved during the period 1931 to 1945. A comparative geographical framework is used to explore Japan's experience on the fringes of China. Beginning in 1931 in Manchuria, Japan successfully applied a developmental model of state-directed industrialisation which emphasized the expansion of railways and infrastructure. A decade later, in 1941, when the Japanese government and military felt under pressure to obtain resources and establish a pan-Asian economic union, it seemed possible to incorporate Southeast Asia into this area. Initially Southeast Asia, wholly under occupation by May 1942, appeared to provide a base to realize this ambition and, like Manchuria, a profitable outlet for Japanese enterprise. However, by mid-1943 the Pacific War begin to turn decisively against Japan. Within a year, Japanese armies were on the defensive and serious food shortages were evident in Southeast Asia. By examining different Japanese experiences and the research efforts of Japanese scholars on the Chinese fringe during Japan's swift expansion into Asia, this Workshop helps to understand the shifting fortunes of Japan during a critical period in its history.
